Price Collectors

Your mission is to collect prices of items assigned to you according to item specifications in Mobile Apps and in a manner that ensures that the prices you collect best represent the actual prices paid by most customers.

Getting started

1. Make sure you have the following at hand:

- a. **CPI Item list.** This is the CPI market basket item list for 2012 put together in consultation with all the DSOs and NSB officials for pricing. See item list at the end.
- b. **Sample Outlets:** The list of sample shops/outlets for price collection. These sample outlets were selected based on **location, popularity, availability of goods** by the respective DSOs in their own locality.
- c. **Smart phones:** Make sure that you all have mobile phone provided by NSB for price collection ready with you.



- d. **Mobile Apps:** The application called Mobile Apps should be installed in your mobile phones. You can download from www.nsb.gov.bt/cpi click on download Apps



- e. **Product Mapping:** This exercise has to complete before going to the field for price collection. DSOs must map all the available products to outlet/shop for pricing. This can be accessed from our website www.nsb.gov.bt/cpi

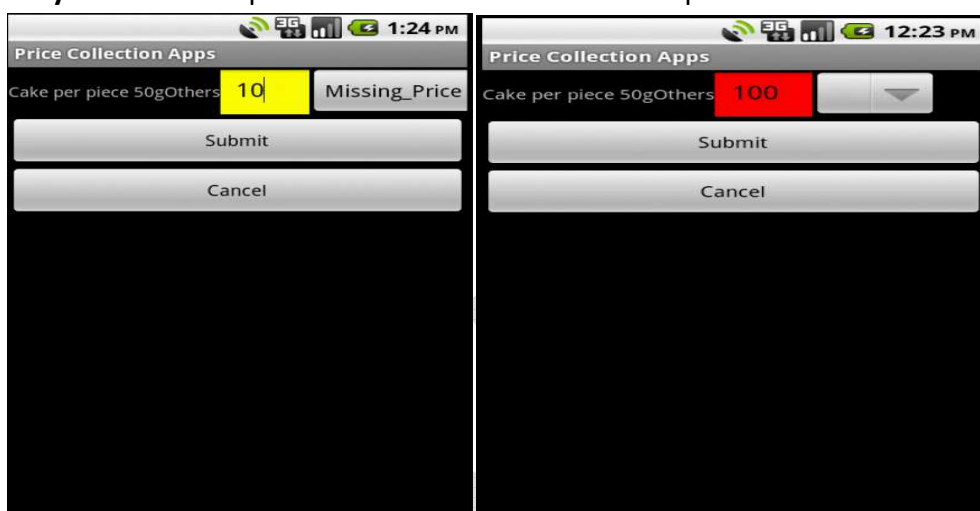

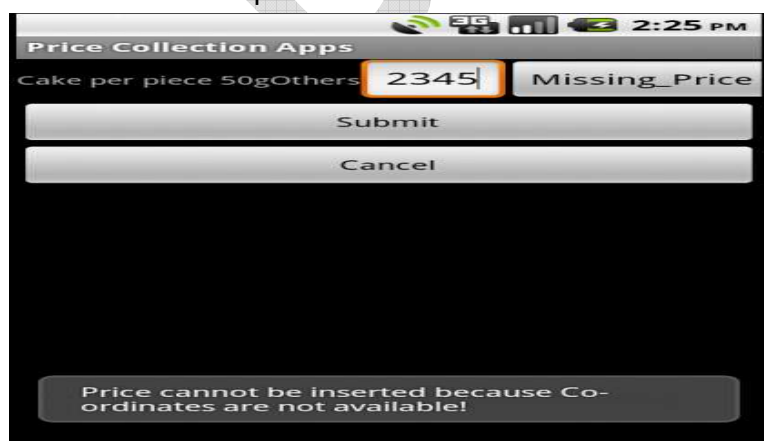

- f. **Schedule of data collection:** The full set of CPI item basket should be collected every month with the exception of services such as **education fees, electricity rate, water rate, postal, communication and transport** charges etc which are controlled by the respective organization.

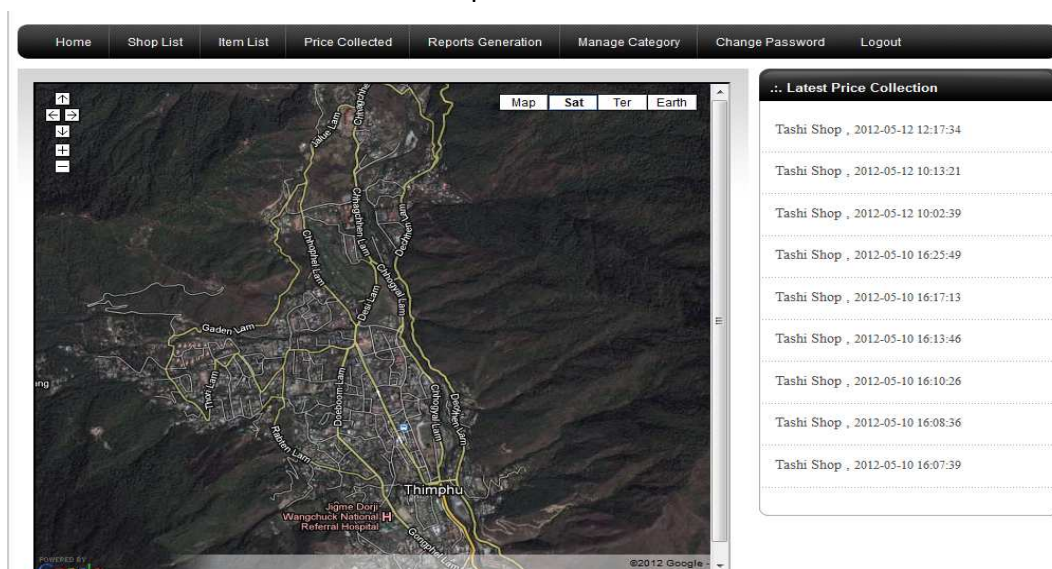
- g. **Number of price quotations:** In order to have a representative and comparable prices within the dzongkhag at least 2 price quotations for each item and maximum up to 5 quotations especially for food items.
- h. **Price entry:** Special attention should be given at the time of punching the prices in the Mobile Apps, as there is no editing facility in the Apps once prices are submitted. There are two inbuilt alert checks in the system **red for high** and **yellow for low** prices. But this doesn't mean the prices are incorrect.



- i. **Remarks/Comments:** By default it's set to normal price in the remarks column. The price collectors have the option to choose other comments but there is no option to write comments.
- j. **Price Submission:** After completing the price survey in one shop/outlet push the submit button before you continue with next shop. The prices you have submitted will be entered online to NSB data Bank. Continue until you complete your entire survey. The price collectors should ensure that he/she has covered all the sample outlets in the area.



- k. **Price Collection Location:** The inbuilt GPS will point the exact price collection location from where the prices are collected.



- l. **Outlet Replacement:** If you have to replace an outlet because it has disappeared permanently or otherwise cannot be used, be mindful of the selection. The new outlet should represent similar clientele and location as the one being replaced.
- m. **Item Replacement:** If the item is missing permanently from the market, you will not replace with another item but inform the Price Section in NSB. Item replacement is done by NSB.
- n. **CPI Basket:** CPI 2012 Market Basket has 446 items as of now.
