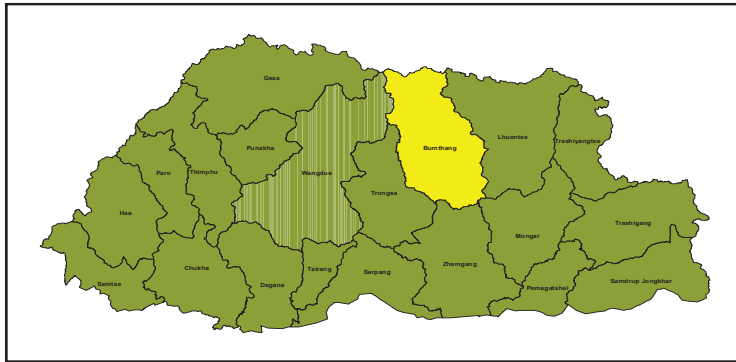

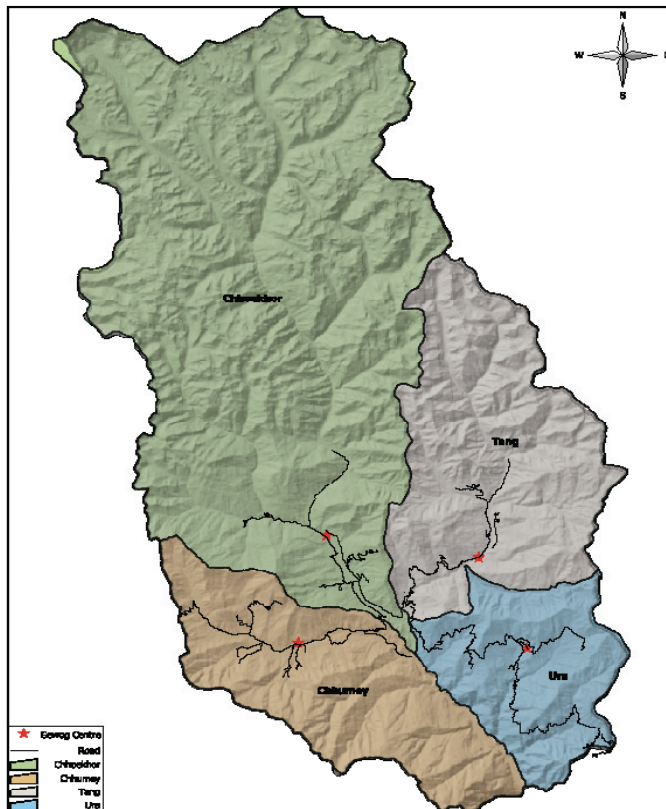

## ADMINISTRATIVE MAP OF BUMTHANG DZONGKHAG

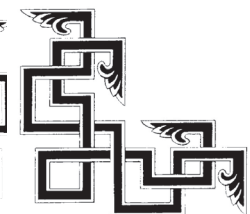
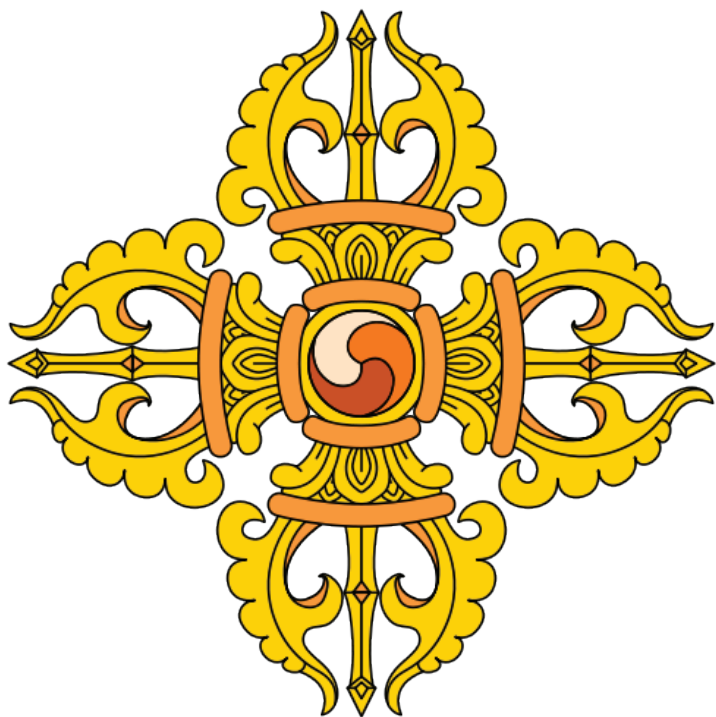
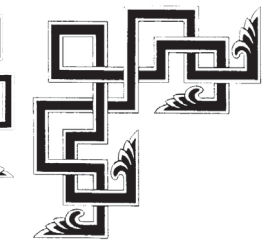


## **FOREWORD**

## Background

Bumthang Dzongkhag, a total area of 2,667.76 Sq.Km with an altitude ranging from 2400-6000 meters above the sea level, has four Gewogs, namely Chhoechor, Chumey, Tang and Ura. It is bordered by China in the north, Mongar in the east, Zhemgang in the south and Trongsa in the west.

As per the Population and Housing Census of Bhutan (PHCB-2005), Bumthang Dzongkhag has 2,870 households and a total population of 16,116 out of which 11,913 live in the rural areas. The project population for 2013 is 18,411.

The main source of income are mainly from cash crops like potatoes, livestock and tourism related activities. The sale of cordyceps, masutake mushroom and medicinal plants are also their supplementary income.

The Dzongkhag has a total road network area of 372.875 Km including 124.000 Km of National Highway from Yotongla to Thrimshingla. Bumthang Dzongkhag has a total of 19 Schools, out of which 12 are Primary Schools, 3 ECCD, 1 ECR, 2 Lower Secondary Schools, 3 Middle Secondary Schools, 2 Higher Secondary Schools with a total of 3,981 students and 255 teachers as of July, 2013. It also has 15 NFE Centre and with 117 NFE Learners and 15 NFE Instructors. Ugyen Wangchuk Institute for Conservation and Environment at Lameygonpa has a total of 28 Instructors and Lecturers with over 35 trainees. Technical Training Institute at Chumey with over 164 trainees and 16 teachers as of August, 2013. Bumthang Dzongkhag has one hospital and five BHUs.

As of 2013, it has a total of 18 mobile towers, out of which 8 towers are Bhutan Telecom and 10 mobile towers are Tashi Cell, the Dzongkhag achieved 100 percent network coverage.

The Dzongkhag also has a mini hydro power plant located at Chumey Gewog supplying power to the local community.



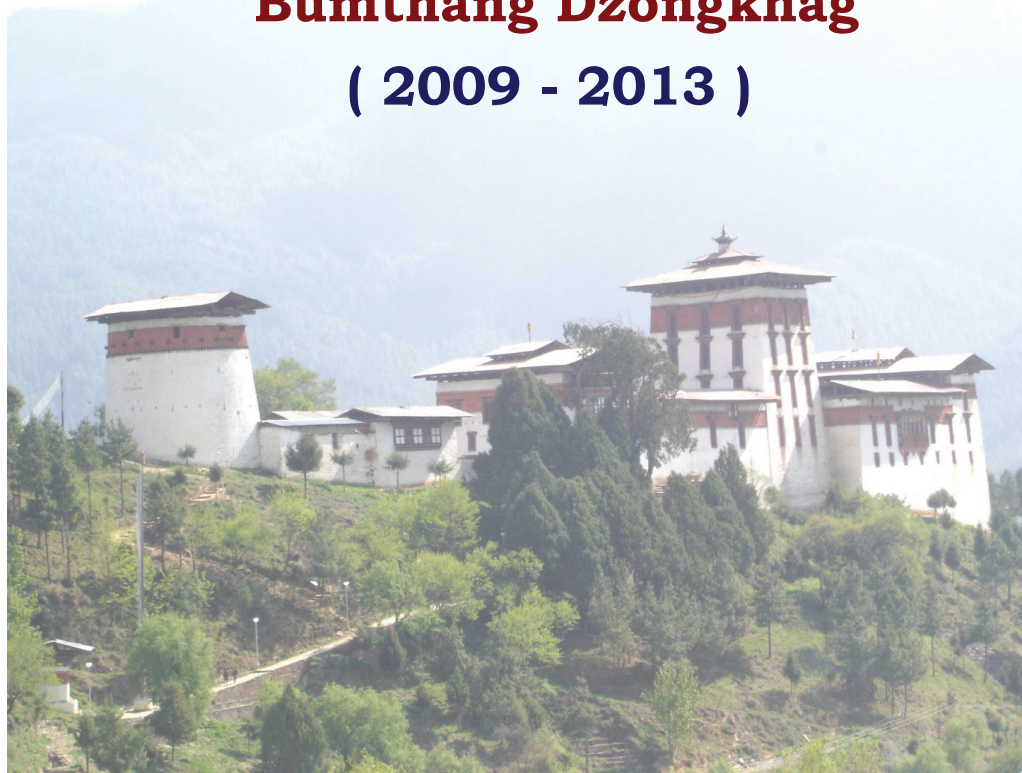

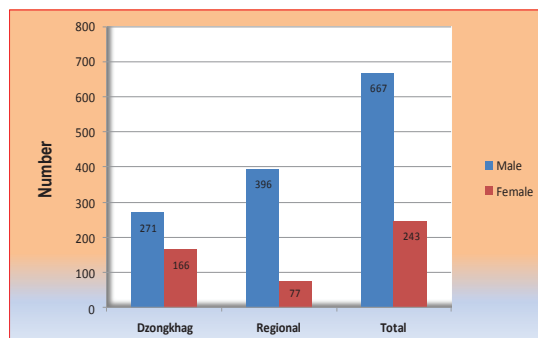

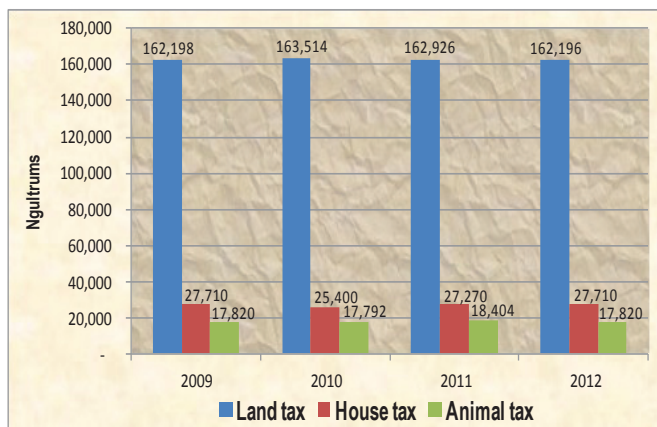

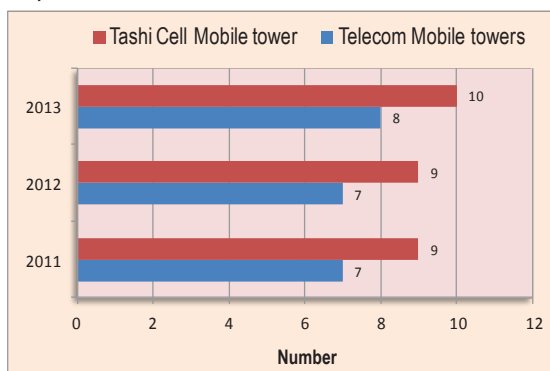

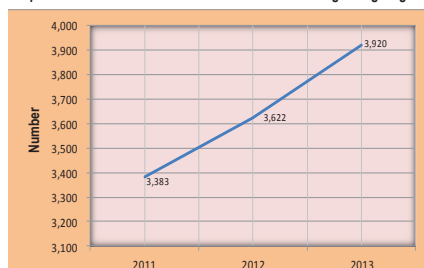

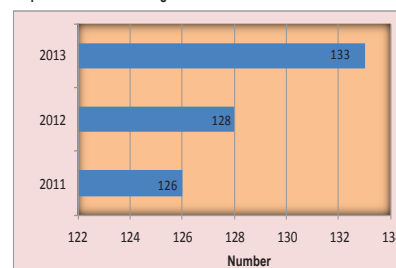

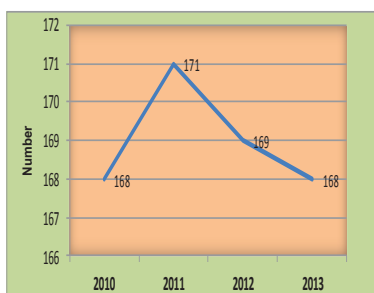

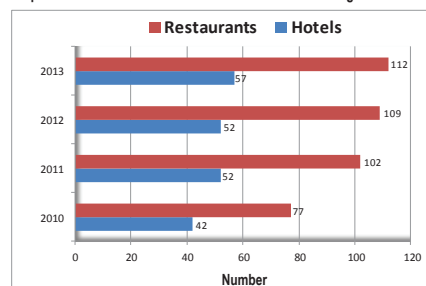

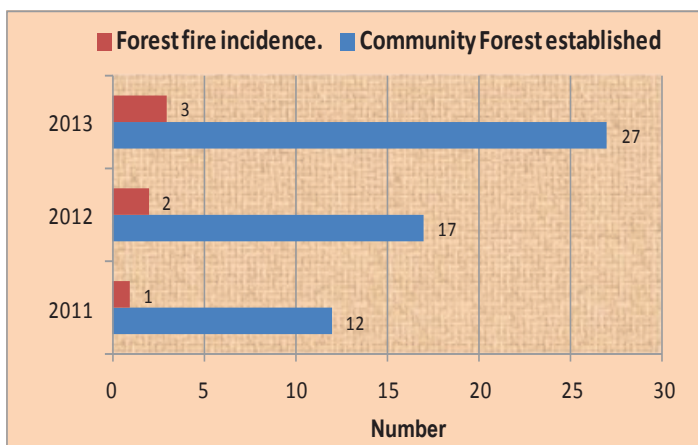

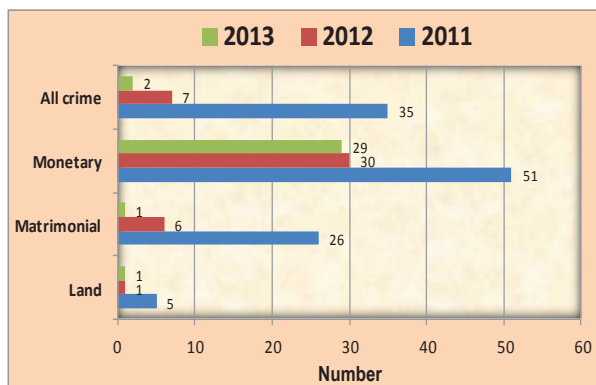

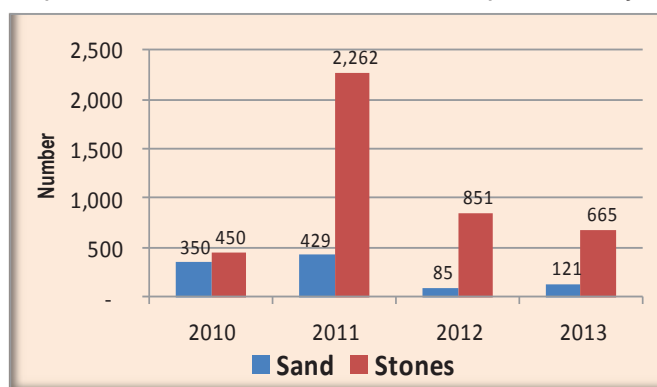

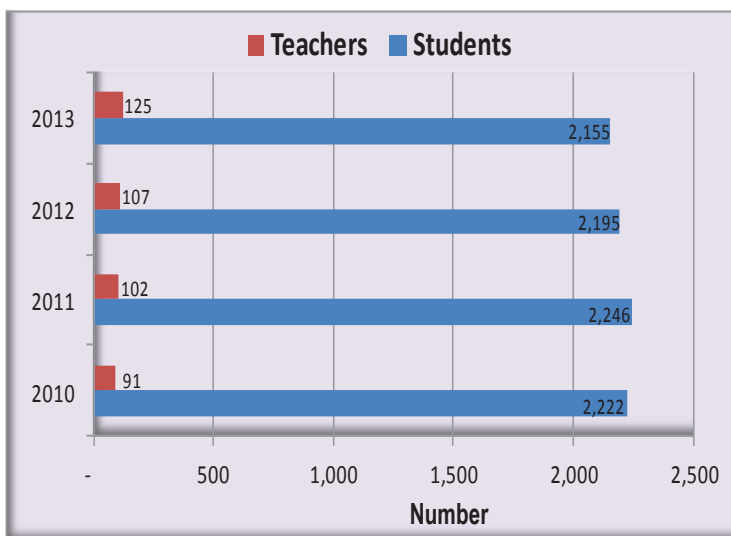

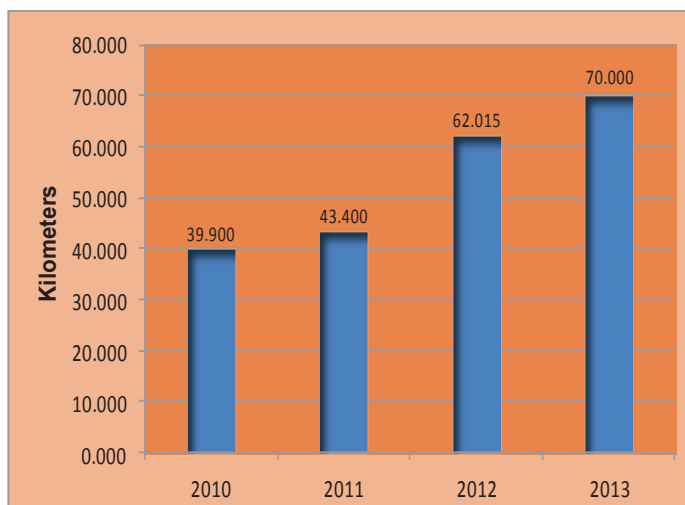

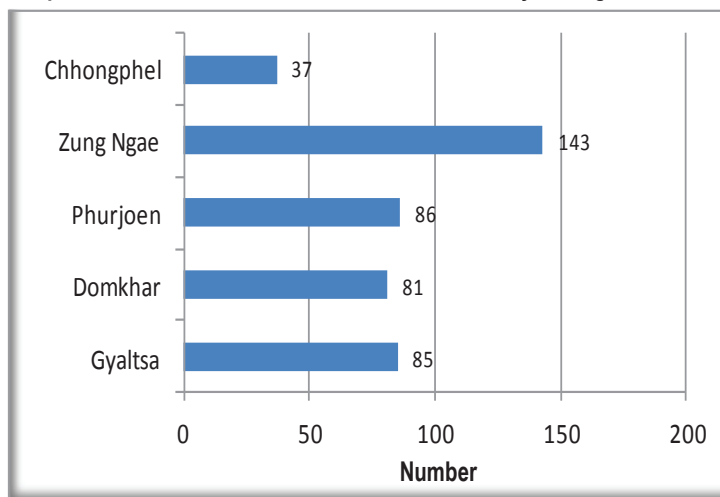

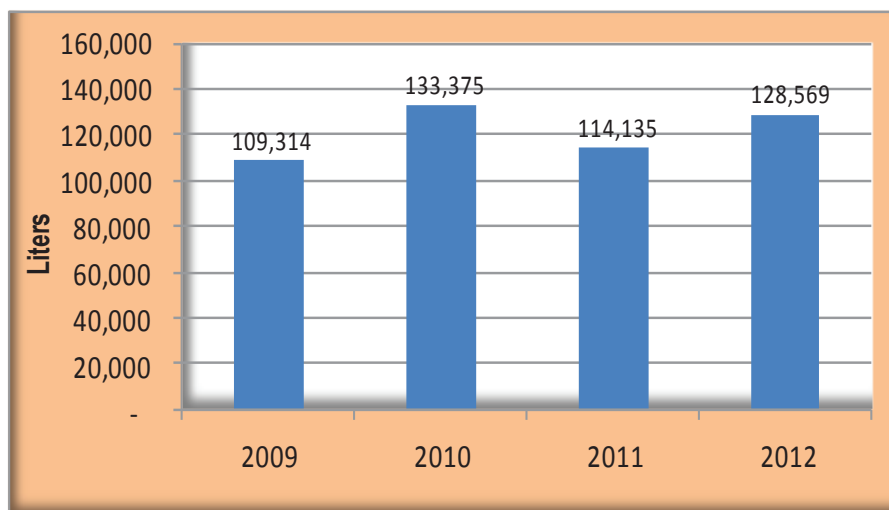

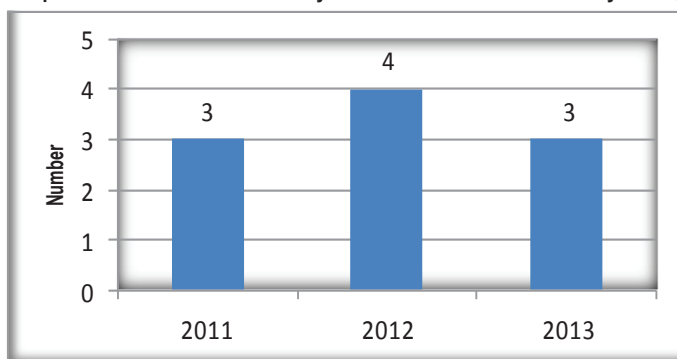

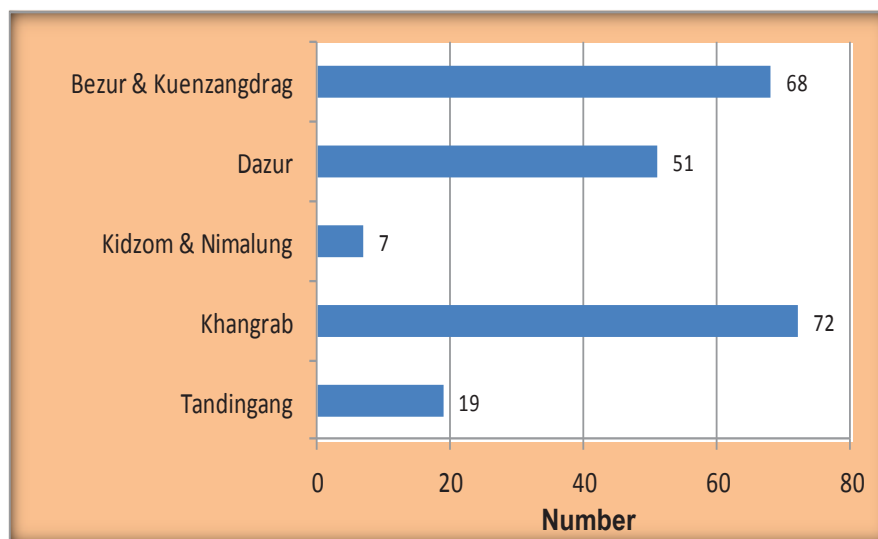

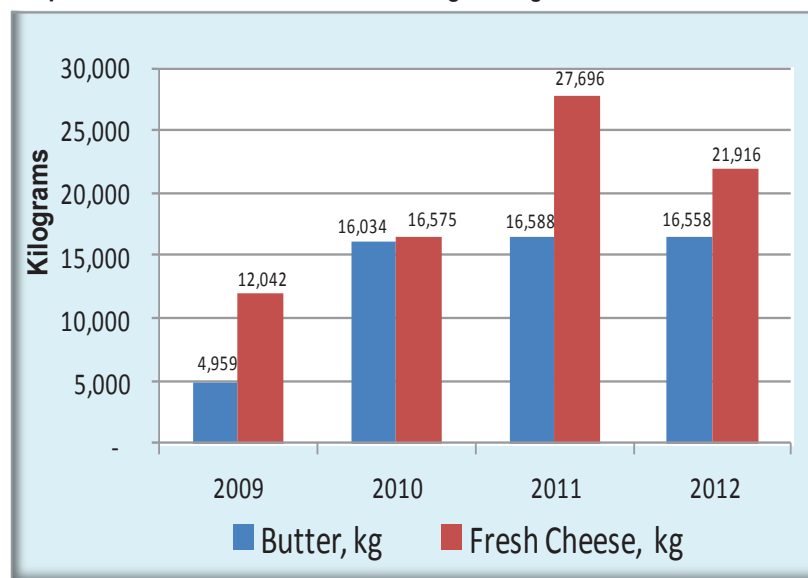

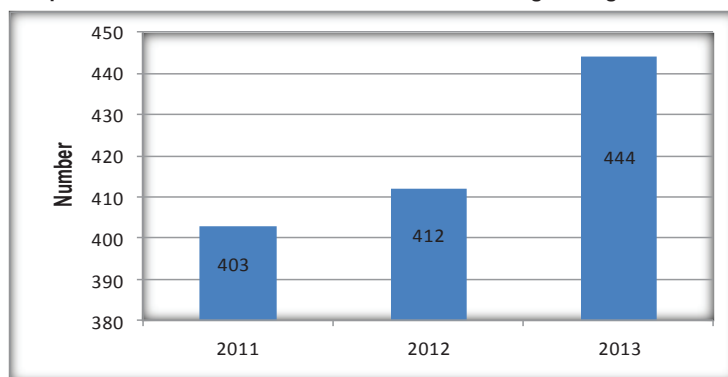

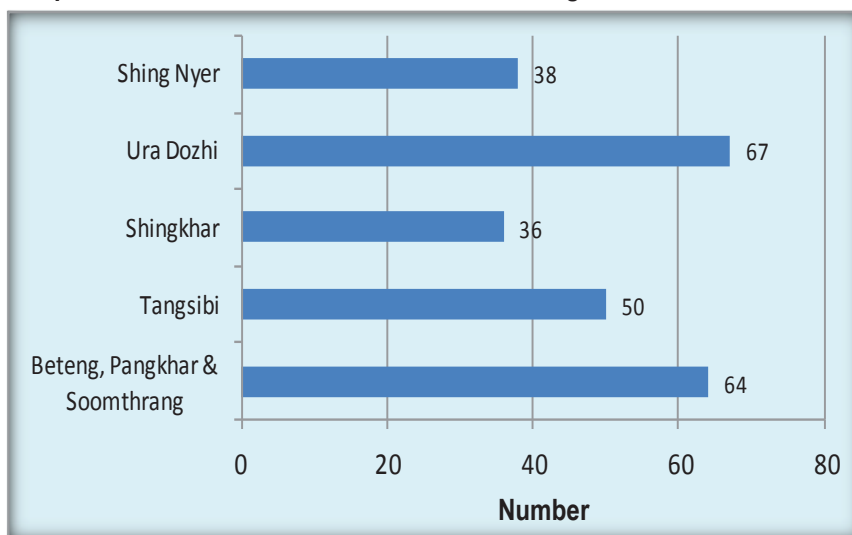

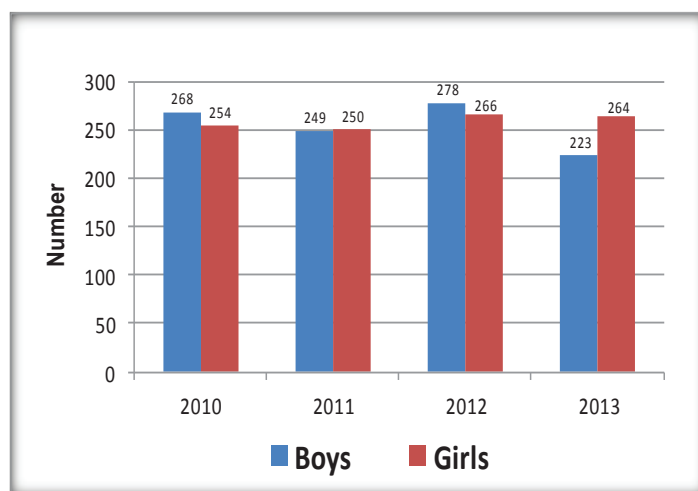

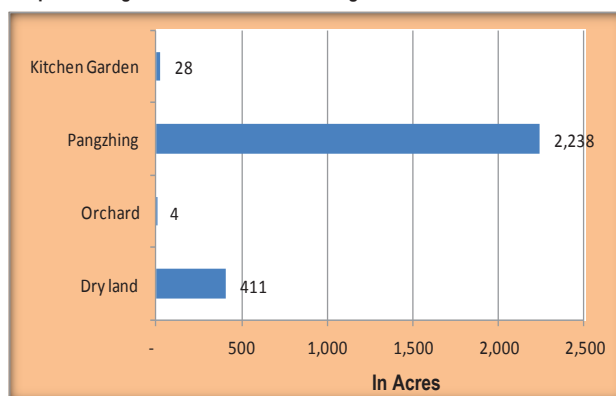
